

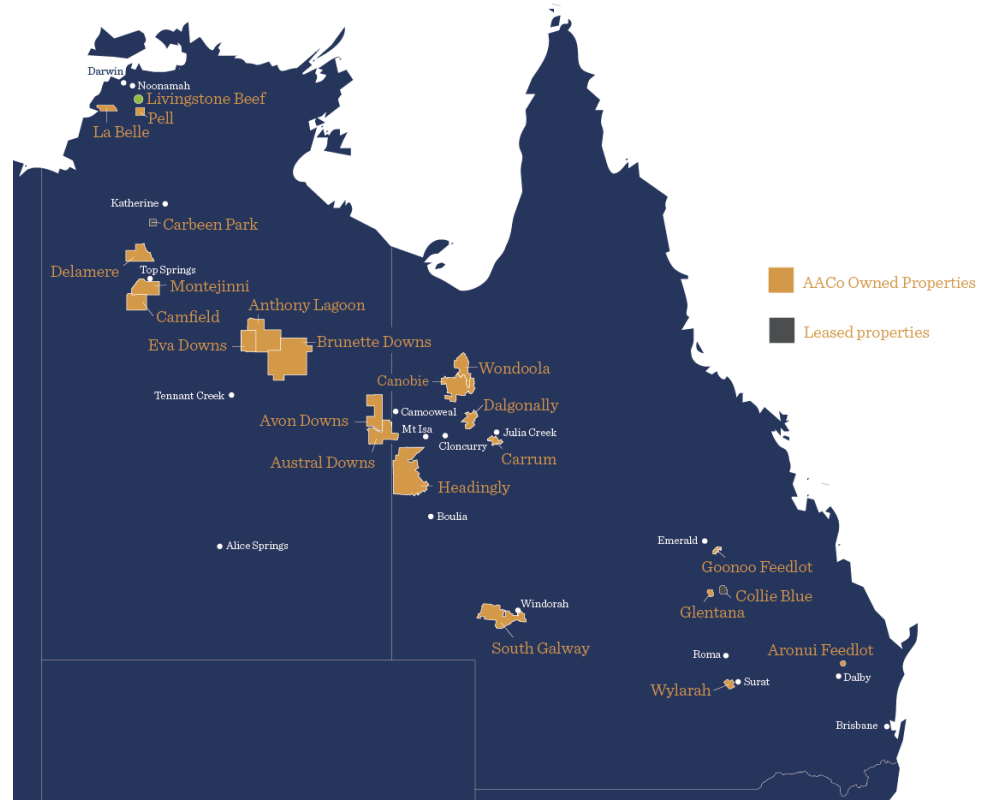

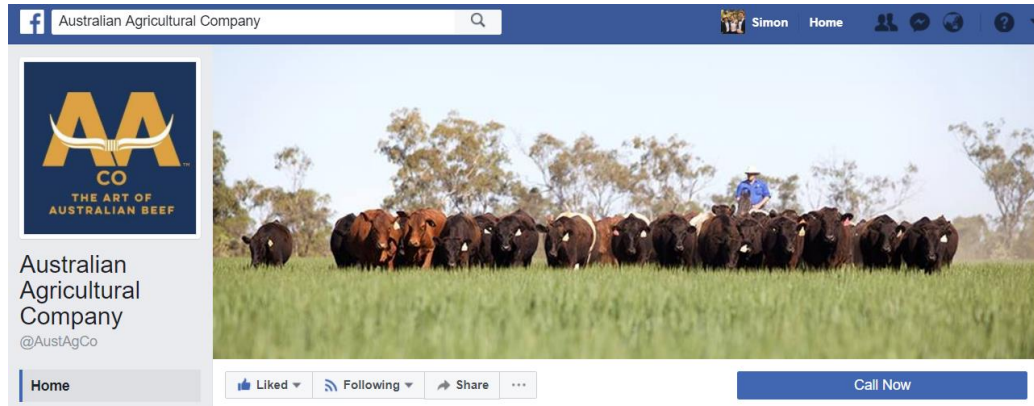
# Graduate Program

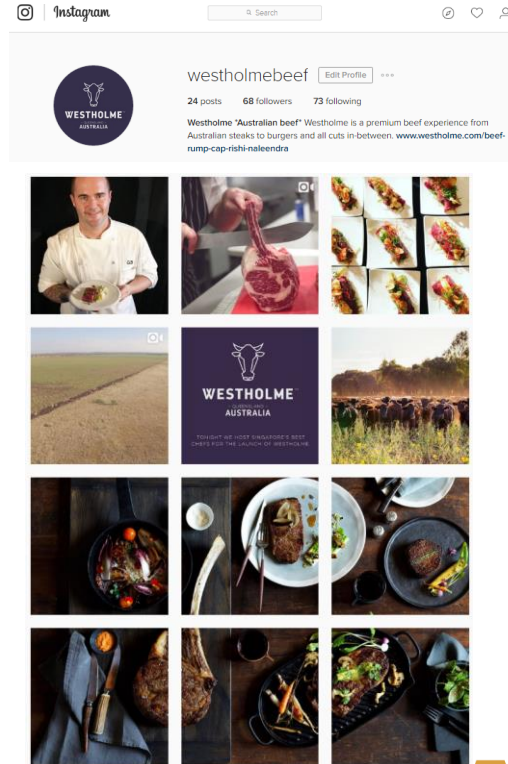
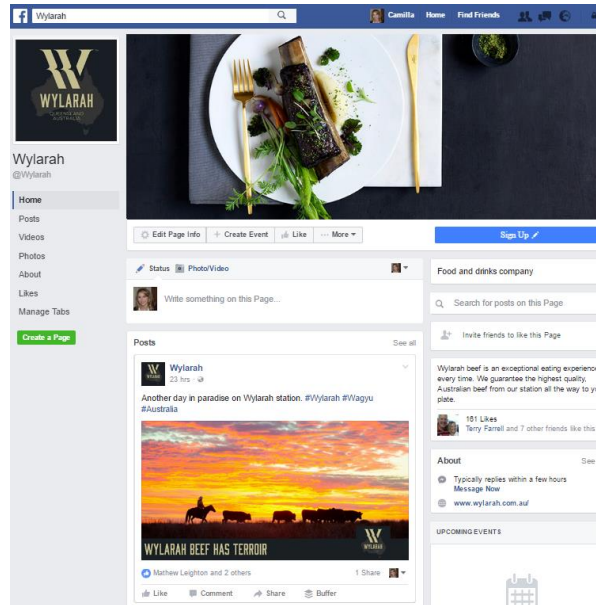
