In addition to the above eligibility criteria, to be eligible for **FEE FREE** training a student must also meet one of the criteria below:

- Be 17-24 years of age, including 2020 Year 12 School Leavers **OR**
- Be unemployed **OR**
- At risk of unemployment (contact us for more info about this criteria)
