Agronomy Graduate Program

- Annual intake, currently open
- Comprehensive 2 year training program with no guarantee of full time placement on completion
- First 12 months is a generalist role split into 2 by 6 month intervals by crop segment. (Broadacre and Horticulture)
- 2nd Year is full time placement at a location by segment of choice
- Graduates will be required to do work placement with supplier and potentially a key client



Agronomy Graduate Program

- Who do we look for?
- All participants must have tertiary qualifications in Agriculture
- Those that have a passion for Agriculture and can demonstrate:
 - confidence
 - motivation to succeed
 - sound communication skills
 - commitment and enthusiasm







- Over 90% completion rate
- Over 90% of those who have completed have been offered ongoing full time career roles within Elders
- Usually 2 intakes each year (8-10 trainees per intake)
- Start date March/April, recruitment open December/January
- Start date September/October, recruitment open June/July
- Recruitment process involves initial phone interview followed by face to face interview. Candidates showing high potential but lacking experience can be referred



- Designed to deliver practical agency training and to provide understanding of all aspects of Elders agency business as a career starting point
- Sales based agency training
- 18 month fixed term employment contract
- Certificate IV in Agriculture
- On-line learning
- Phone-based sessions / Case studies

- On-job training/assessment
- Opportunity to apply for full time role



Who do we look for?

- people who have a passion for agriculture, as well as having:
 - Effective communication and interpersonal skills
 - Self-motivation
 - Work ethic
 - A desire to build a long terms sales career with Elders in the livestock, wool or livestock production advice industry
- As successful candidates will be required to relocate throughout the Elders national network, those best suited will have worked away from home for a minimum of 6 months prior to applying.
- Trainees who successfully complete the program are given the opportunity to apply for permanent livestock, wool, or livestock production advice roles with Elders.
